**A RESOLUTION REPUDIATING THE APPLICATION BY AUGUSTIN PLAINS
RANCH (APR) TO MINE WATER FROM THE SAN AUGUSTIN BASIN and DENYING
INTEREST IN BECOMING END-USERS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees met in a Regular Meeting on Monday, September 26, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at 108 N. Main Street, Magdalena, New Mexico; and,

WHEREAS, APR, in their updated application submitted to the State Engineer, lists the Village of Magdalena as a planned end-user of mined water; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Magdalena has not been contacted by APR concerning the provision of water and denies that it is a willing or necessary end-user; and,

WHEREAS, the grant of APR's application would have disastrous consequences to the Village, nearby ranchers, and the Very Large Array (VLA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees for the Village of Magdalena that it is not interested in becoming an end-user, contrary to the APR's assertion to the State Engineer, and strongly opposes the updated Application.
